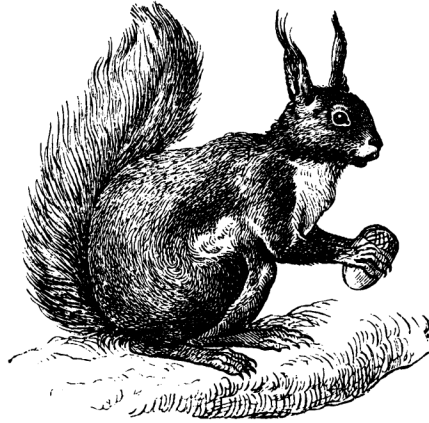
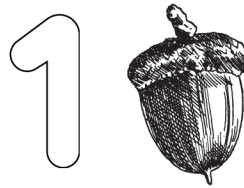


Story Math

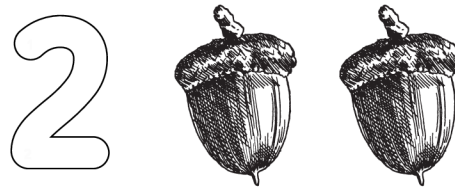
This is a squirrel. He is gathering acorns for the winter.
