Teacher Instructions

Read the words in **bold** out loud to your learner.



(point to *au*) **These letters, *a* and *u*, work together to make the sound *au*.**

You hear the *au* sound at the beginning of the word *August*. Say the *au* sound three times: *au, au, au* (point to the *au* each time)

(point to *aw*) **These letters, *a* and *w*, work together to make the sound *aw*.**

You hear the *aw* sound at the beginning of the word *awesome*. Say the *aw* sound three times: *aw, aw, aw* (point to the *aw* each time)



Practice reading these words. Point to each word as you read it.
