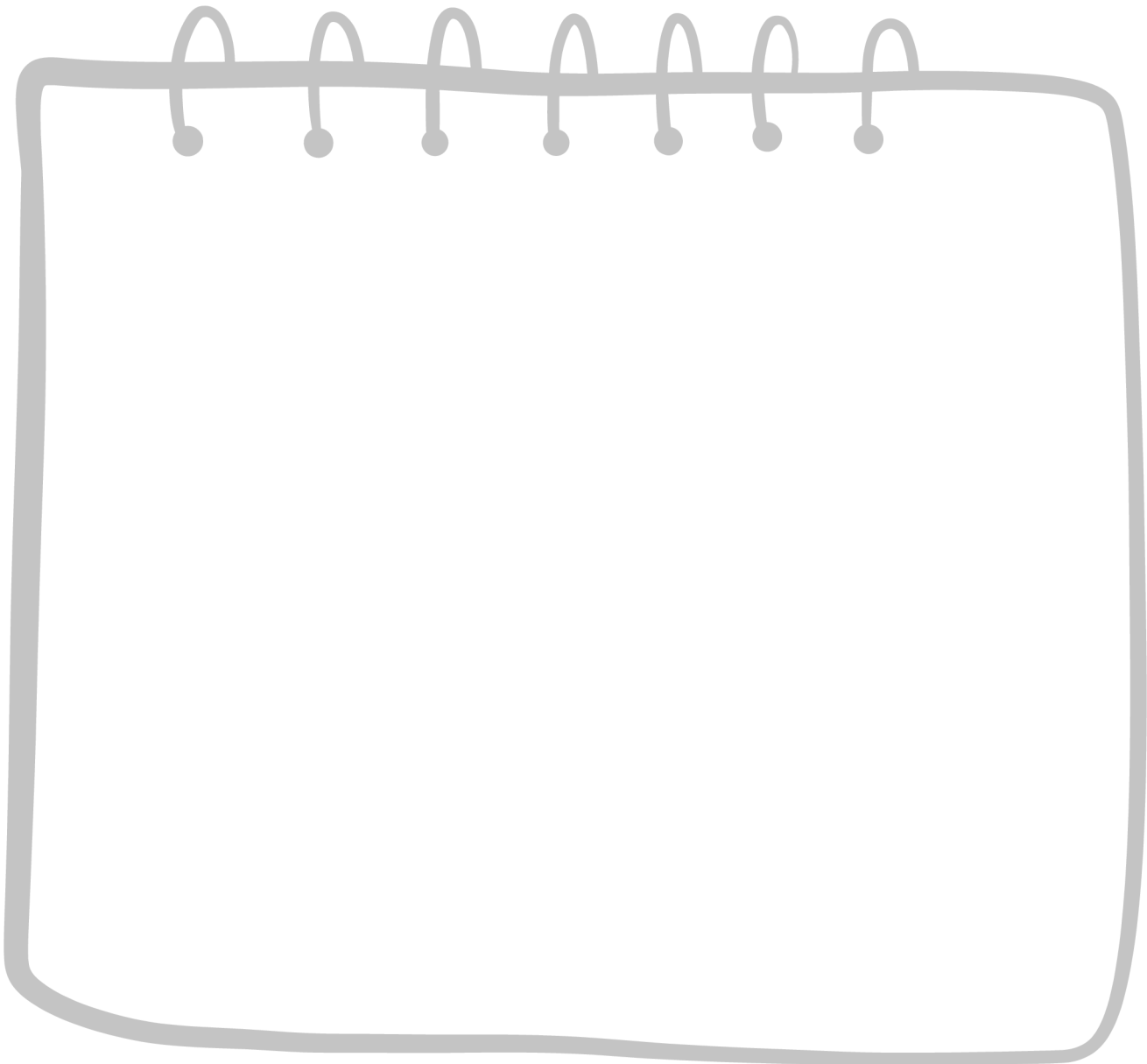


◇ DIAMOND SEARCH
