(point to *gh*) These letters *g* and *h* work together to make the sound *gh* like the sound at the end of the word *laugh*.

(point to *ough* and *ough*) These letters *ough* and *ough* put together make the same sound.

You hear the *ough* and *ough* sound in the middle of the words *bought* and *caught*.



Now we are going to learn another way *o* can sound.

Sometime when there is a *silent e* at the end of a word with an *o* in the middle, the *o* makes the *u* sound, like the first sound in *umbrella*.
