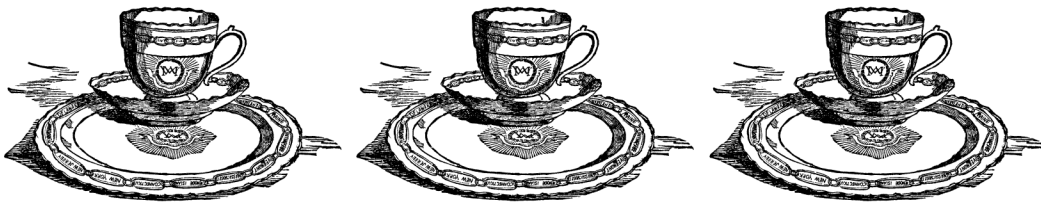


Story Math
